## UP AND CLOSE WITH MS. KRITIKA JAISWAL : THE INSIGHTS OF AN IAS

**“Being successful is the best way to eliminate your enemies and if you want to eliminate the enemies of your nation, be a bureaucrat.”**

The team of Kaleidoscope was commissioned for a visit at her residence to have an interactive session with the newly appointed bureaucrat, IAS Ms. Kritika Jaiswal. Her alma mater, the Integral University, witnessed the making of an IAS officer. Having graduated from IT, faculty of Engineering, she was also a part of the renowned 2008 batch, the first ever batch to pass out, after the prestigious Integral Institute of Technology was granted the University status back in the year 2004. She excelled with flying colours with the AIR-778 in UPSC 2014.

**Ma'am what is the story of your life, from being an alumni of Integral University to being an IAS?**

Passing out from Integral University I worked in Allahabad Bank until 2013. It was in the year 2012 when I started the Civil Service preparations and after three years of perseverance and back breaking toil that I am able to tell you the tale of my life.

**What was the major challenge that you faced during the course of your preparation?**

My major setback was the accident of my father in the year 2010. He went into a state of coma after the accident for an entire month. Even after retrieving from coma he was amnesiac and was thus hospitalized for almost eight months. The period really hampered my studies but with every hardship that came my way I got the courage and motivation to move forward accepting the adversary.

**What was the role of your parents in your struggle?**

Expectations of my parents were definitely very high from me but they never pressurized me for exhaustive long hour studies. On the contrary it was my own passion which made me go mad in search of my destiny, my childhood

dream. Yes, they were always appreciative of my achievements but always reminded me of my ultimate aim. Parents are for sure the best critics one can find. Even if they are strict at times it is for your own better good.

**What is the best way to tackle the interview?**

The panel which conducts your interview is an elite group of professionally trained interviewers who conduct interviews not only for IAS but for IFS, ATFCs, CMOs, etc. You'll have to be very honest and original with your answers. No beating around the bush will work here.

**What were the questions that were hurled upon you in the interview?**

It was Manbir Singh Board. He is an IFS officer so the major questions were based on international politics, world affairs, contemporary history, especially of the two world wars, women based issues, artificial intelligence, genesis and aftermath.

**What is the secret to your success?**

I was persistent with my efforts, moreover it was a regular and rigorous study pattern that helped me a lot in the long run. It was difficult to manage time at first along with the job as time management is very crucial for smart preparations. After my first attempt in the year 2013 I quit

my job and was able to seek more time for studies. Success is contemporary with sacrifices. The sooner you make them the faster you succeed. I never watched the idiot box for entertainment, but watched it for infotainment with channels like Rajya Sabha and Lok Sabha.

**Ma'am with due respect what shall be your first initiative to make a change in the society?**

See after my training is complete and I join my cadre I would like to establish an NGO whose main objective shall be to stop child and women trafficking, liberate bonded and child labors and work for the welfare of women.

**What is the message you want to give to the aspiring bureaucrats?**

As the saying goes there is hardly any short cut to success, so work hard and if you are honest with yourself you will definitely taste success sooner or later. Many times you'll feel it is better to give up than to set such high goals. If ever in life such a demeaning thought comes to your mind do remember we don't lose on failing but we lose if we lose on trying again.

## PROJECT UNDER ALUMNI NOW WORKING AS FACULTY AT IU.

### Dr. Alvina Farooqui

Dr. Alvina Farooqui, Associate Professor (Jr.), Department of Bio-Engineering, has been awarded **"Young Scientist Project"** from Council of Science and Technology, Uttar Pradesh. The project entitled **"Development of Novel Screening System Employing Cyanobacteria for Toxicity Studies of Metallic Nano-particles"** will have Dr. Alvina Farooqui as the Principal Investigator. This project aims to develop cyanobacteria based screening system for evaluating the toxicity caused by increasing

concentrations of environmentally prevalent metal nano-particles. This will not only provide us a new, cost effective model system but also allow us to observe the changes caused at cellular and molecular level by providing us the toxicity data of these pollutants. This is the first, foremost and unusual hypothesis of Dr. Farooqui which will establish Cyanobacterial Cell Lines as a counterpart of mammalian cell lines for toxicity assays of metal nano-particles.

Bioinformatics and Computational Biology from **Council of Science & Technology**, Uttar Pradesh. The duration of the project is three years with A total funding amount of Rs. 9,33,000/-. The acclaimed proposal against Anti-Angiogenic leads certainly creates an interface of novel screening protocols for multiple molecular targets to ascertain the bioactivity of an unknown compound, prior to be taken into expensive and tedious drug development protocols in wet lab.

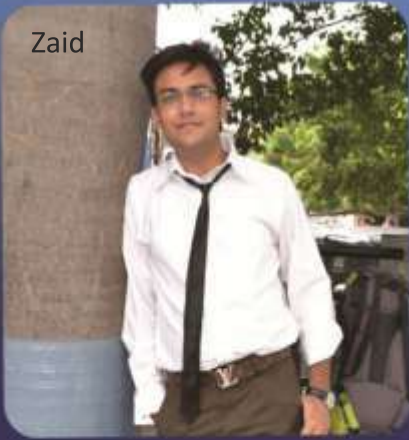

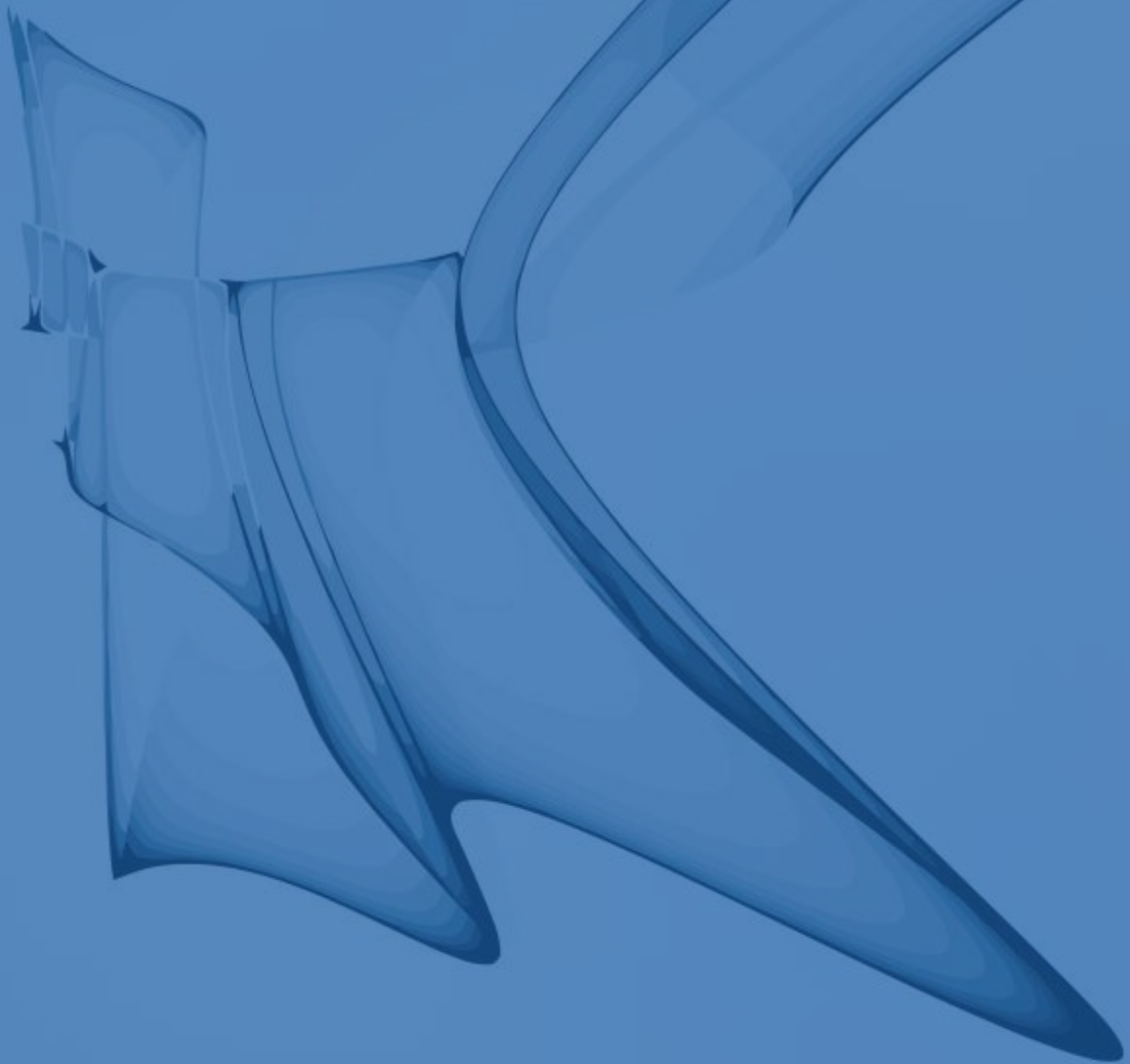
*Coffee, a magic word with a magic power.....*

Then, you only need to give strokes where you want to have darker shades and leave it for drying. Repeat these steps until you get what you want. Then, for the last touch mix glue (fevicol) with coffee and water and give the last finish to your sheet by highlighting the outer peripheries, shades and shadows.
