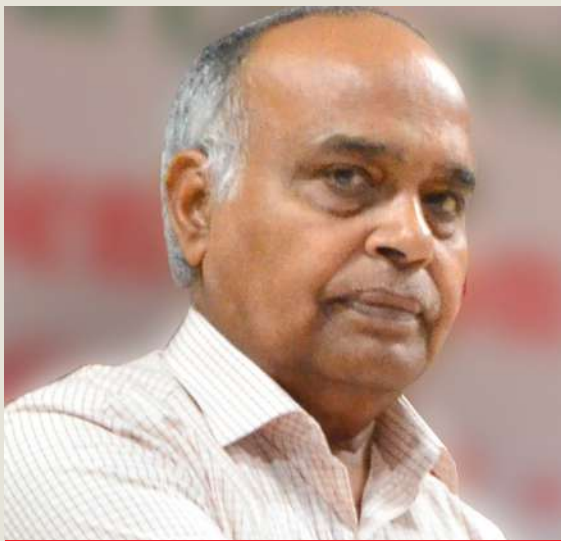


Pro-Chancellor's Message

CAMPUS NEWS

MoU inked between Integral University and Council of Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR)-Indian Institute of Toxicology Research (IITR), Lucknow.

An MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) was signed between CSIR-IITR (CSIR-Indian Institute of Toxicology Research), Lucknow and Integral University, Lucknow on Friday, 18th September 2020.

The signing of this MoU will open new doors of possibilities for the students of Integral University, Lucknow. Under this collaboration agreement, special emphasis has been provided on Education, Research and Training components. Integral University will encourage its student to participate in R&D in collaboration with CSIR-IITR.

The said MoU was signed in the auspicious presence of Prof. Aqil Ahmad, Vice-Chancellor (Acting), Integral University, Prof. Alok Dhawan, Director, Indian Institute of Toxicology Research, Dr. Mohammed Haris Siddiqui, Head, Department of Bio Engineering, Integral University, Dr. K.C Khulbe, Head, Research Planning and Business Development Division, CSIR-IITR and Dr. Devendra Parmar, Chief Scientist, System Toxicology & Health Risk Assessment, CSIR-IITR, Lucknow.

For agreed upon activities, both institutions will make available their facilities and staffs. This MoU will take effect on and will be valid for five (5) years. This MoU may be renewed for another period of five (5) years upon mutual written consent of the parties before the expiration date.

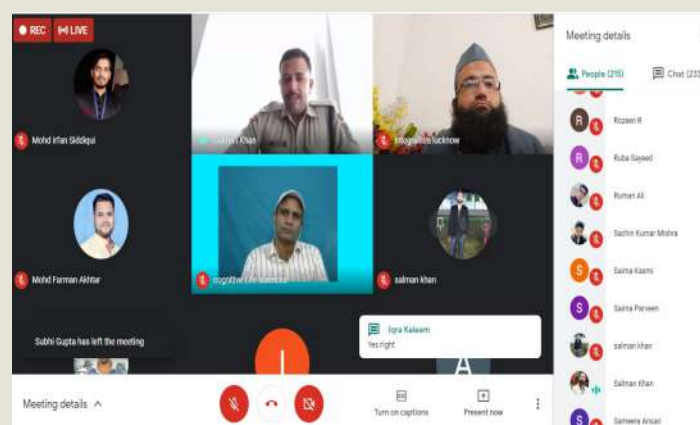
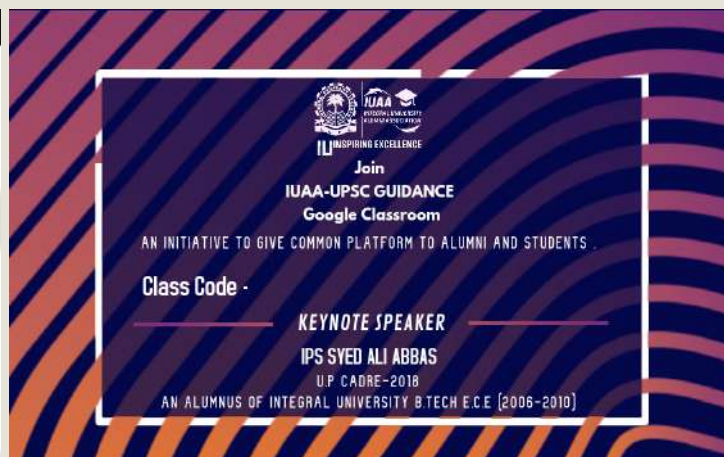


IPS Syed Ali Abbas
